DISCOUNTED HOMEMAKER CHORE SERVICES

Yontinue living safely in your home! ⁷ Thanks to a generous grant from the Senior Fund City of St. Louis, Jewish Family and Children's Service is able to provide homemaker services to city residents 60 years and older. The grant will provide up to 20 hours per week of assistance with meal preparation, laundry, personal care, transportation, shopping/errands, and light housekeeping. The hourly rate is discounted based on a person's need. These services are primarily for older adults in situations where they need some support but have limited financial resources or assistance from family or friends.

RATE REDUCTION OFFERED BY MSD

The Metropolitan Saint Louis Sewer District (MSD) offers a Customer Assistance Program to qualified low income, elderly and disabled customers who receive sewer service from MSD. Qualified customers will receive a rate reduction equal to 50% of the current charges for wastewater services on their monthly sewer bill.

Who is Eligible?

- Disabled or Seniors at least age 62
- Income cannot be more than \$32,200 annually for an individual or \$43,550 annually for a couple.
